## APPLICATION FOR A VETERANS' LICENCE PLATE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA - A Veterans' licence plate is available to an Alberta resident who has been Honourably Discharged or is Still Serving under the following requirements.

<ul> <li>Rease check applicable box</li> <li>A) Has served in either the Canadian Forces, Canadian Reserve Forces, Allied Forces or Commonwealth Forces during WWII, the Korean War, Gulf War or NATO/UN Missions.</li> <li>B) Has served in either the Canadian or Allied Merchant Navy or the Ferry Command during war time.</li> <li>C) Is currently serving or is an honourably released member of the Canadian Regular Forces with a minimum of three (3) years paid service or has been medically released under Section 3A or 3B.</li> <li>D) Is currently serving or served in the Canadian Reserve Forces with a minimum of 1,095 days paid service.</li> <li>E) Is currently serving or is an honourably released member of the RCMP with a minimum of three (3) years paid service.</li> <li>F) Is a member of a Canadian Police Force who served in a Special Duty Area or on a Special Duty Operation (NATO/UN).</li> <li>ETERANS INFORMATION: The Veterans name must be on the vehicle registration. Vehicle(s) may e registered jointly with partner.</li> </ul>

OCUMENTATION REQUIRED. It is the responsibility of the Veteran to ensure that a copy of their service ocumentation is included. These documents must be in English. CFOne cards not accepted.  MILITARY RETIRED PERSONNEL: CF Certificate of Service or NDI75 card (both sides) or Allied Forces Certificate of Service or Canadian or Allied Merchant Navy Service Record Book. Proof of Medical Release under Section 3A or 3B.  MILITARY STILL SERVING PERSONNEL: Both sides of the CF ID card and a current Military Personal Record Resume (MPRR).  RCMP RETIRED MEMBER: Record of Service ID Card.  RCMP STILL SERVING MEMBER: Service ID Card.  CANADIAN POLICE FORCE: A letter from a Senior Officer or other proof of service for any NATO or UN operations, including dates.  Documentation will be returned with the approved application.  The completed application, copy of proof of service, self-addressed/stamped envelope, cheque or money order
